More than 1000 top archivists from 90 countries will gather in Australia next week to try and solve the challenges of the digital age. The International Council on Archives (ICA) congress, *A Climate of Change* will be held in Brisbane from 20 – 24 August. The four-yearly congress, held in Australia for the first time, is hosted by the National Archives of Australia.
